

BATH VOLUNTEERS FOR SERVICE GRANT

Grant Guidelines

(Revised January 17, 2002)

The Bath Volunteers for Service will be awarding an annual \$4,000 grant to a graduating senior from Revere High School to further his or her education in college, trade school or vocational school.

The grant will be based on financial need with the stipulation that the recipient must have at least a 2.0 grade point average.

Application forms for the BVS grant may be obtained at the Revere High School Guidance Office; the "Revere High School Local Scholarship Awards" application form will be used. They will be available beginning February 27 and must be submitted by April 24, 2014.

The recipient of the BVS Grant will be determined by a selection committee composed of at least one BVS member and a representative from the Revere High School faculty.

Grant money will be awarded before the fall semester each year as follows:

For a 4-year school-- \$1,000 for the first year and \$1,000 for each succeeding year in school up to a total of 4 years.

For an 18-month or 2-year school--\$2,000 for the first year and \$2,000 for the second year.

Continuation of the grant is contingent upon maintaining the status of a full-time student with a 2.0 or better grade point average at a college, trade school, or vocational school. Remaining grant money will be forfeited if the student withdraws from school or fails to maintain the required 2.0 grade point average. If a scholarship recipient has not made contact with BVS or BVS has not been able to reach the recipient for one academic calendar year, the scholarship will be terminated. The money will revert to the scholarship fund.

The grant money will be payable to the school which the student will be attending and must be applied to tuition. The check will be forwarded to the student for inclusion with payments for other school fees.

The grant recipient should submit before the fall semester of each year the following information:

Your name, home address, and telephone number.

School and address of school you will be attending.

A copy of the school's bill

A copy of your school transcript from the previous school semester.
